- The Beth C. Wright Cancer Resource Center and Healthy Acadia collaborate to provide community-based cancer patient navigation to cancer patients and their caregivers. Washington County has the highest rate of cancer mortality of any Maine county.
- Our patient navigators offer support to cancer patients and caregivers and empower them to overcome barriers to their care. These barriers include but are not limited to: financial/economic assistance, health/healthcare literacy, health insurance navigation, access to transportation, connection to social/support networks and systems, and access to resources that support healthy diets and lifestyle habits to complement individual treatment and recovery protocols.
